



2021 14th Barra Bonanza Competition Rules

All competitors must be registered by 1800hrs & attend briefing 1900hrs on the 28th Oct. (If not, all competitors can attend 1 representative from each team must be present to collect anglers' bags and angler ID tags)

Any line class may be used. All captures must be caught on rod reel or handline. Minimum 2 anglers per team; maximum 3 anglers per team. Junior anglers may be part of a team.

Junior entrant must be under 16 years of age at time of tournament, not at time of nomination. (Tournaments start date is the 29th of October 2021)

To be eligible as a senior team, all team members must be of senior age.
To be eligible as a Junior Team, all team members must be of junior age.

Individuals and mixed senior/junior teams not are not eligible for any champion and runner up team prizes.

MAJOR Prizes is for Barramundi only (Individual & Team prizes)

An angler can submit all Barramundi photo measurements towards the major prize.

For Mangrove Jack, Javelin fish (Grunter) & Threadfin Salmon (Blue and King), all anglers are encouraged to submit all legal sized fish to the app as these 3 species will have a combined total for the best of 5 fish for each species throughout the tournament. For Mangrove Jack, Javelin & Threadfin Salmon no undersize fish will be accepted, as per tournament minimum rule size. Minimum & maximum lengths of qualifying species as per briefing.

The last day of Barra Bonanza tournament 30th, all fish photos for that day must be uploaded to the before 1600 hrs

ONLY ONE (1) SENIOR ANGLER IS ELIGIBLE FOR ENTRY INTO THE \$250,000 PRIZE DRAW

- 1 All fish must be clearly photographed on the 2021 Barra Bonanza brag mat with angler's id tag.
- 2 Submitted photos must show time, date and gps location.
- 3 Any photos submitted without these specifications will not be accepted.

All captures eligible must be clearly recorded on Phone showing anglers id tag, time, date and gps location.

To be eligible all photos must be taken on an official Barra Bonanza Brag mat which coincides with the year in which the brag mat is issued for the tournament. (E.g., 2021)

The photo must clearly display the angler's id tag, time date and gps location stamp.

Event officials reserve the right to reject photos that they believe do not meet the criteria

The full fish with nose of fish against rest, the brag mat measured length, anglers ID tag, time, date and gps location all must be clearly visible in the photo

Boundaries

Southern Boundary

Southern bank of Fishers creek and east from the mouth from 18 26.138

Northern Boundary

Northern bank of Dallachy creek and east from the mouth from 18 09.946

Western Bruce Highway

Fishing restrictions are in place around all prawn farms, fishing near these farms could introduce serious diseases, line fishing is prohibited within 100 meters of prawn farm water intake and outlet channels and all fishing is prohibited in drainage channels surrounding these prawn farms.

You will be disqualified if caught fishing in the areas

ALL competitors are eligible to win the lucky door prize (boat, motor, trailer in their respected category). This includes Cardwell Sportfishing Club members and Sponsors. If you have paid the nomination fee, you are eligible.

The three (3) Cardwell sportfishing club judges' decisions is final.

There will be a third-party expert unattached to the Cardwell sportfishing club who will supervise and oversee the drawing for the major prize of \$250 000.

SUBMIT YOUR CATCH

All anglers are encouraged to submit all eligible species fish captures as any fish could upgrade your own score

Consumption of Alcohol

Event organizers have a duty of care to competitors and guests and request that consumption of alcohol is kept within the confines of the law.

Event organizers reserve the right to refuse the sale of alcohol to any competitors or guests.

Alcohol must be consumed within the boundaries of the Cardwell Sport Fishing Club.

Anyone consuming alcohol can be asked to provide photo identification at any time.

Tickets bought for consumption of alcohol are non-refundable

No BYO alcohol is permitted to any event site within the Cardwell sport fishing club.

Alcohol can be purchased on-site. The Cardwell sport fishing club promotes the responsible consumption of alcohol.

Designated Outdoor Smoking Area (DOSA)

Patrons can order their drinks then take them into the DOSA, and smoke and drink there.
